



FANTASTIC FANFARES! Composing Competition 2022

Details of the competition have been sent to local schools, but entries are very welcome from any young person, anywhere in the country.

Subject to the number of entries, we hope to have two categories:

- Fanfares written and scored for acoustic instruments
- Fanfares intended for reproduction electronically only

These will be judged separately for:

- students aged 13 and below
- students aged 14-18


Prizes will be awarded to the winners. The overall winner(s) will be awarded a **Dorico Pro** license, whilst **Dorico Elements** licenses will be awarded to the composers of first 25 entries received.

It is hoped to be able to play the winning fanfare(s) at a concert during the **2022 Proms at St Jude's** festival.

The brief:

- Fanfares should be no longer than 30 seconds
- Entrants should provide:
 - 1) a written score
 - 2) an mp3 recording
 - 3) a short paragraph describing their approach to composing their fanfare and
 - 4) a completed entry form
- Fanfares should celebrate the Platinum Jubilee of Queen Elizabeth II (incidentally Proms at St Jude's will also be celebrating 30 years).
