## **Our impact**



#### OUR AUDIENCE

- Over 4,300 visitors typically since 2018
- 27% of tickets sold to newcomers
- Audience comes mainly from North London

#### **OUR CONCERTS**

- Nine days of world class musical concerts
- Recent performers include members of the Kanneh-Mason family. Nevill Holt Opera, Aurora Orchestra, Choir of King's College Cambridge, Liza Pulman, Jess Gillam and VOCES8



#### LITFEST

- Eight events normally in one weekend (seven in 2022)
- Over 550 people typically attending since 2018
- Recent authors include Hilary Mantel, Colm Tóibín, Jon Sopel, Bart Van Es, Alan Rusbridger, Robert Peston, Simon Jenkins, Nicholas Hytner, John Preston, Philippe Sands and Claudia Roden

#### HERITAGE WALKS

- Over 200 participants annually
- At least 10 walks around north and central London
- Over 750 people participated online in 2020











#### WORK EXPERIENCE

- Opportunities provided for **Middlesex University students**
- About 15 students, aged 16-18, each year

#### **VOLUNTEERS**

- 40 volunteers on Board and committees
- Over 100 volunteers at the Festival

#### COMMITTED TO EDUCATION

- 3,400 local students have attended free live concerts
- Online concert resource for schools reached 4,000 children in 2021
- 460 children have attended **Teeny Proms**
- Outreach to children and young people in Barnet and the East End

- Concert performance opportunities to young and rising musicians
- Fanfare composition competition for older pupils
- Support Youth Programmes at Tovnbee Hall
